- Who wrote it: The Apostle Paul–1:1, 13, 3:4-6, 16:21, Acts 18 When was Paul in Corinth: 50-52AD 2nd missionary Journey The Date 1 Corinthians was written: 55AD from Ephesus 3rd The two fold Purpose for the letter to the Corinthian Church.
- 1. To Rebuke the Saints for the shocking sins being permitted within their local church.
- 2. To Correct their doubts about what is Sanctified living.

- 1 Corinthians 15:1 Moreover, brethren, I declare unto you the gospel which I preached unto you, which also ye have received, and wherein ye stand;
- 2. By which also ye are saved, if ye keep in memory what I preached unto you, unless ye have believed in vain.

- 1 Corinthians 15:3 For I delivered unto you first of all that which I also received, how that Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures;
- 4 And that he was buried, and that he rose again the third day according to the scriptures:

Christ died for our sins: ...for He was cut off out of the land of the living: for the transgression of my people was He stricken And that he was buried: ...And He made His grave with the wicked, and with the rich in His death; Isaiah 53:8c-9a and that he rose again: ...For thou wilt not leave My soul in hell; neither wilt thou suffer thine Holy One to see corruption. Psalm 16:10

3. The Gospel Message has many witnesses!

- 1 Corinthians 15:5 And that he was seen of Cephas, then of the twelve:
- 6. After that, he was seen of above five hundred brethren at once; of whom the greater part remain unto this present, but some are fallen asleep-(died).
- 7. After that, he was seen of James; then of all the apostles.
- 8. And last of all he was seen of me also, as of one born out of due time.

- 4. The Gospel Message provides God's forgiveness & favour.
- 1 Corinthians 15:9 For I am the least of the apostles, that am not meet-(worthy) to be called an apostle, because I persecuted-(pursue) the church of God.
- 10. But by the grace of God I am what I am: and His grace which was bestowed upon me was not in vain; but I laboured more abundantly than they all: yet not I, but the grace of God which was with me.
- 11. Therefore whether it were I or they, so we preach, and so ye believed.

Acts 13:38 Be it known unto you therefore, men and brethren, that through this man is preached unto you the forgiveness of sins:
